Examples of the type of business may include but is not limited to dog walking, housecleaning, lawn care or "handyman" tasks.</p> <p>They will work closely with clients in order to plan and promote their business, advertising/ poster development, on site trouble shooting, any barriers as they arise, obtaining necessary tools or resources to complete the work.</p> <p>Responsible to: The successful candidate will be supervised directly by the ACTT manager and work daily with the vocational specialist and or PSR specialist in carrying out the plan developed with the ACT team.</p>

Other details	<p>The Huron Perth Assertive Community Treatment Team supports individuals in the Huron and Perth region who suffer from severe mental illnesses. In Huron county, we are supporting approximately forty individuals living in their communities. Throughout our involvement, we hear from our clients that they are interested in employment but are not actively seeking employment for a variety of reasons. They cite readiness, stigma leading to a lack of willing employers, lacking skills and lack of support in the search for and maintaining a job. Our program has a vocational specialist who assesses interest and links clients to various services to support work. Missing from this service is the ability to work side by side with the client to develop work, trouble shoot on the job or focus on the very real pragmatic skills required to work.</p>
