Job Description	<p>The Personal Support Worker (PSW) is responsible to provide personal resident care under the direction and supervision of Registered Practical Nurses and Registered Nurses, ensuring high quality care is given and maintained for all residents, while adhering to current policies &amp; procedures governing the facility. The PSW is responsible for the residents' activities of daily living including, but not limited to, restorative care, feeding, bathing, dressing, walking, toileting, lifting and transferring and meeting their behavioural needs. The maintain familiarity with the residents' individualized plans of care, assist with the development of nursing care plans and participate in nursing care conferences. They assist with all aspects of meal service and the distribution of snacks, supplements and water jugs, feed residents as necessary and ensure that residents receive appropriate hydration. PSWs complete all documentation records as directed, e.g. hydration, care, bathing, 7 day logs.</p>

Once trained, the student will undertake all of the duties of a PSW, with proper supervision.
